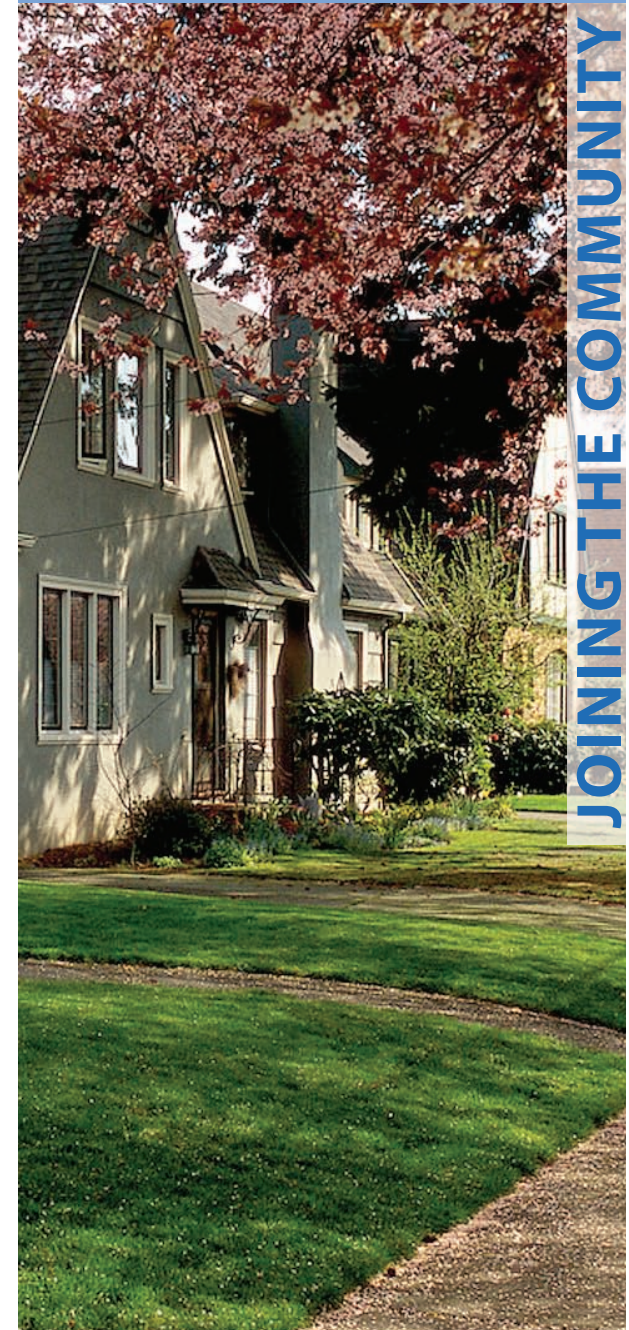

# LIVING IN THE COMMUNITY

## When You Move In:

- Get acquainted with your neighbors early.
- Take pride in your neighborhood. Keep your yard, driveway and sidewalk area clean.
- Recognize that you are in a residential neighborhood and not everyone is on the same time schedule. Be considerate of your neighbors.
- Remind your guests that you live in a residential neighborhood and that you would appreciate their help by eliminating loud street conversations, loud stereos, modified mufflers and speeding.

- Remember, City ordinance allows only three unrelated people to live as a family in a single family home.

# PARKING

- City ordinance requires that landlords provide for tenants parking needs on their lot. Please remind the tenants to keep the streets clear and their neighbors driveway accesses open.

# TRASH

- Curbside containers need to be placed within two feet of the curb with the handle and wheels pointed away from the curb.
- Containers must be removed within 24 hours of pickup.
- One plastic bag, securely tied may be placed on top of container.

# ANIMALS

- The City of Ruston has a leash law that prohibits dogs from running at large.

- Pens, yards or confinement areas must be cleaned regularly.
- Persistent barking and howling by your pet will be considered a "Disturbing the Peace" violation

# MOSQUITO CONTROL

- Concern for the West Nile Virus has made mosquito control a priority in every community. Make sure you have no standing water in any ditch, pool, tub, bucket, can or any container in your yard.
