'Envisioning Day' kicks off Ruston's city planning efforts

RUSTON — The city's long-range planning effort got off to a big start as more than 400 citizens participated in a citywide Envisioning Day at the Ruston Civic Center.

It was part of Ruston 21, the city's planning process for the future. Citizens added their ideas on what they want Ruston to be known for in the future. The information will be tabulated and distilled into a document that will be released publicly in a few weeks.
